<p>When importing rstsandbox of rst0.9 in python (trunk installation from debian packages), you get an unclear error/warning/message: No handlers could be found for logger "rstsandbox"</p> <p>This doesn't seem to be a problem, as I can use sandbox types afterwards, but the message is unclear and confusing to the user. Reproduce with a python script as simple as this:</p> <pre>import rstsandbox v = rstsandbox.generic.Value_pb2.Value() v.type = 2 v.int = 2 print v</pre>
