(make-static): new function; configure reloading of libraries from previous locations
(make-dynamic): new function; configure reloading of libraries from new locations
- main/dump.lisp (toplevel): call `make-dynamic' instead of directly reconfiguring network.spread
- cpack/DebianUbuntu.cmake: decompress binary in postinst hook
- main/package.lisp (header): updated copyright
(package rsbag.tools.main): added exported symbols make-static and make-dynamic
