Description

In my experiments with the oncilla-sim.distribution, it seems, that thebuild-generator doesn't find any dependencies for libcca-oncilla.project. The project is build in the the first build-flow chunk although it has lots of dependencies.

I tried to execute the job configurator with just the libcca-oncilla.project and in --debug mode, to see what's happening. But even then, their is no complaining about missing providers, so this seems to support my hypothesis, that dependencies are somehow not extracted from the project.
