#### Description

It seems that in case the project version did not change, setuptools sometimes does not install the fresh version of a project unless you use `python setup.py install -f`. I would suggest to use this as the default since we always want to ensure that things are installed correctly.

I could not add this behavior with the existing option structure since I could not find a way to specify simple flags that do not take a value.
