```
DEPRECATED_MSG(FooPtr Foo::bar(int baz), "deprecation");
FooPtr Foo::bar(int baz) {
}
```

resulting in

error: declaration of 'static FooPtr Foo::bar(int)' outside of class is not definition

as well as

```
DEPRECATED(FooPtr Foo::bar(int baz)) {
}
```

resulting in

error: attributes are not allowed on a function-definition
